

## Filler Plates, MPF



These filler plates provide a flat mounting surface in bayed enclosures when the mounting plate is not fitted flush with the frame. The continuous mounting surface created allows the space to be used more efficiently.

### FEATURES

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Description: Covers the space between pairs of adjacent mounting plates to provide a continuous working surface, when two enclosures are mounted together.

Material: 2 mm zinc plated steel.

Pack quantity: 1 plate with mounting accessories.

For bayed configurations MPD02 must be used along with the fixation brackets supplied with the enclosure and mounting plate. MPA06 must be used if the enclosure comes without fixation brackets. MPF cannot be used with mounting plates if they are installed in the most rear position.
